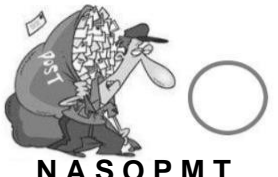

A mechanic Woman

Nikki Evans is a car mechanic in London. She used to be a librarian. We asked her why she decided to work with cars. "My first reason was independence", she said. "I also wanted to use my hands, and I like to learn how things work. Besides, I concluded that many people prefer to have a woman repair their cars.

"Nikki didn't find it easy to become a car mechanic. She had to attend a Skills Centre -- a special sort of college where people can learn a new job -- for twenty weeks. She tells us about it:
